

4. Printer Paper Replacement



- Step 1. Press 'OPEN' Button to open printer cover.
- Step 2. Insert a new roll of paper in the correct orientation.
- Step 3. Pull the roll of paper and set it in the middle of printer and close the printer cover.


5. Stand assembly

Internal view (screw assembly location)




Step 1. Assemble the unit vertically on the stand








2. Assembling the stand and base plate


Step1. A guide is protruded from the stand. With the protruding guide, align the holes on the base plate.

Step2. Use included 9x Washer Bolt (M6) to secure both the stand and




Internal view (screw assembly location)

4. Fixed anchor bolt (4x pieces required)



Step1. Refer to the drawing to make four \varnothing 10mm holes.


Step2. Fix the four bolts to the \varnothing 10mm hole.

- Installation choices -

1. Attaching double-sided tape to stand



Step1. Lay the stand down and attach the double-sided tape referring to the image.


Step2. Place the product in the desired location.

Caution

- Remove dirt, water and grease from adhesive surface prior to use.
- Press the adhesive tape firmly for 3 seconds after attachment.

2. Level control (optional)


* Helpful when leveling the product.



Step1. If the product is not leveled, use the included tin wrench bolt (M10).

Step2. Align the supplied hexagonal wrench roll.

3. Rubber pad attachment



Step1. Attach the rubber pads to the flat surface (ground).

Step2. Place the stand on the rubber pad.

- * Rubber pads are used to protect the floor.
- * Remove any debris on the adhesive side of the rubber pad.

- 1. If an anchor bolt is not fixed, the product will not be liable for any property/bodily injury damages.
- 2. All work should be done on a flat surface.
- 3. Product should be placed on a flat/leveled surface.
- 4. Due to the weight of the product, it must be equipped with safety equipment.
